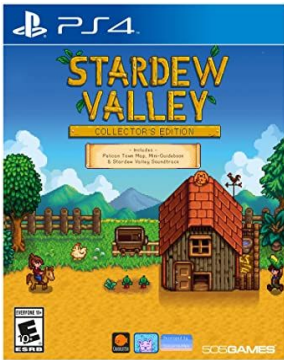
Minecraft *Price: around \$20 (depends on console). Console: Most popular are PC, Xbox*
