

iPhone 11: is it worth it?

Apple is always coming out with new products whether it is a new Macbook or a new version of AirPods. But they are well known for their many versions of iPhones. They came out with two new phones already following up the iPhone X series, which was recently released. The iPhone 11, iPhone 11 Pro and iPhone 11 Pro Max are their new upcoming products. Are they really worth it?

The iPhone 11 is the first of the series. Display roughly coming out at 6.1 inches. It is waterproof, has a 17-hour battery life span, and an A13 bionic processor making it the fastest iPhone you can buy. It also comes in fun colors including green, purple, yellow and even the classic red is back. The biggest thing many people are buying this iPhone for is the camera. The iPhone 11 has a dual-camera making wider shots easier, shooting everything from 4K video to beautiful portraits. Use the camera to zoom out for sweeping landscapes or vast interiors.

The iPhone 11 Pro, on the other hand, is actually coming in at a smaller display than the iPhone 11 at 5.8 inches. They both have an A13 bionic processor and are waterproof. The iPhone 11 Pro comes in Gold, Space Gray, Silver, and Midnight Green. As well as having a battery life of 18 hours. The big difference between this and the iPhone 11 is that the camera, the triple-camera system in iPhone 11 Pro adds a Telephoto lens for pro-level portraits and the ability to zoom in on distant subjects like wildlife and sporting events. The only difference between the Pro and the Pro Max is that the iPhone 11 Pro Max has a display size of 6.5 inches, so really it's just a size matter.

The iPhone 11 series does have some neat features that are introduced that aren't really demonstrated in earlier models. If you are looking for a phone to use for photography and good photos, then this one might be the right fit for you. But, who knows, Apple might come up with a new iPhone within the next 5 months that have better features than this one.
