Eden Park: Eden Park is a part of the Cincinnati Parks, and as a matter of fact is one of the most popular. 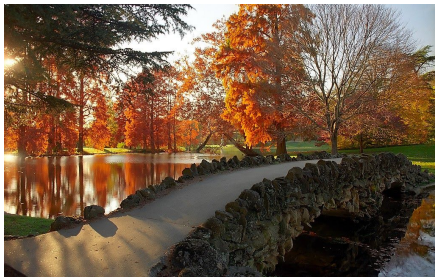
The Dexter Mausoleum is possibly the most popular of places to visit. The mausoleum dates all the way back to the 1860s

when it was built for the patriarch of the family Edmund Dexter who died at the end of the Civil War, and is where four generations of the Dexter family rest. Although you are not able to go into the building, the outside of the mausoleum still yields a stunning picture. Another spot to stop is at Geyser Lake. Located towards the front of the cemetery, the lake is a staple place to visit. Geyser Lake is surrounded by colorful trees and has a beautifully built bridge that you can take your photos on.
